



"Mainstreaming Gender in Student Support Services" : Library & Registrar, A 3-Day Seminar

The University Library together with the Office of the University Registrar had a 3-Day seminar at Pandan, Antique, last September 1-3, 2022 with a theme "Mainstreaming Gender in Student Support Services": Library and Registrar. The three (3) day seminar offered of different activities and seminar topics.

Three speakers who conducted the seminar were Ms. Emily Dela Cruz the Director of the University Gender Center, who discussed the topic of Gender Orientation. She relayed the Gender Orientation advocacy that aims the "Development" it is about attaining a full and satisfying life. She also tackled hindrances of reaching Development, aiming for equality for Men and Women in society and encouraging women to practice what their professions and be productive.



The second speaker was Dr. Russ Allen Napud who discussed about Completed Staff Work (CSW), he guided employees to familiarize themeselves on usual documents needed, how to prepare the documents before the date that is usually submitted, prioritize those that are needed immediately and make sure to double-check and read the documents repeatedly, have a format of those documents being requested to order to save time and hassle.



Librarians attended a four (4) day seminar at Milas Hill, New Lucena.


