These topics were discussed to promote a clean, factual Digital Information that the university was aiming. On the other hand, Ms. Somcio in terms of library services, echoed the library personnel to critically evaluate information found online and be vigilant distinguishing between credible and unreliable sources especially that the library as the center of the university learning should be the first to recognize those.

Ms. Rovilyn D Somcio together with Mr. Raymond Peter T. Tolentino Principal III of NIS (Standing in front) discussed the partnership that the both parties agreed.
- **3**. The proposal of the library extension program (LIBRO) Library of Information Bringing Resources **Openly.** Wherein it had gone into many phases before implementation. It has to pass an In-House review where the university librarian Ms. Rovilyn Somcio needed to convince the panel of five (5) on how and why this project is relevant to the institution as well as the community.
- 4. On March 6-8 of 2024, Ms. Rovilyn D. Somcio, the University Librarian, attended the Writeshop on Engendering University Extension Full-Blown Proposal at the Marceily Point, San Lorenzo, Guimaras. The activity conducted a positive critique for the proposed project in this way, participants know the weakness and strengths of the project. This is also a way for them to enhance and advance the effectiveness of the extension program that they are proposing. The **LIBRO** project is the first extension projects that the university library engaged to extend its services outside the university premises. It will be a good start for both parties to rely on each other for building a foundation to foster future generations in giving updated factual information to faculty and students through this extension service.


















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# University Library Conducts Systemwide Bi-Annual Meeting

A Gender Responsive Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Seminar was conducted last May 03, 2024 at the Function Hall of ISATU TLE Center. This was attended by different participants from the various campuses of ISAT U. Several library employees also attended the seminar. Two speakers shared their knowledge and expertise to the participants on that day. Professor Ricardo P. Bagarinao Director, Center for Open and Digital Teaching Learning of UPOU talked about Household Disaster Preparedness dealing with the different vulnerabilities of every household, anticipating hazards and creating a responsive preparedness plan before disaster occurs. On the other hand, Associate Professor Maria Emilinda T. Mendoza discussed Death and Disaster, reiterating the common future is now our current world and that we are living in a VUCA world filled with wicked problems. Whereas VUCA are qualities that make a certain situation difficult to analyze, by understanding the (VUCA) Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity and Ambiguity it will definitely improve the strategies/mitigation on how to solve a certain problem that may cause a disaster.

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
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# University Librarian attends AVACCUP Accreditation training: Trends, Updates and Directions.

Somcio the University Librarian and also, a university accreditor attended an Accreditation Training: Trends, Updates and Directions last May 14-16, 2024 at Eulogio Amang Rodriguez Tanghalang Sining (EARTS) University of Rizal System, Morong



Campus . It is a Back-to-back Training of Accreditors for preliminary levels I and II surveys and the conduct of 3rd and 4th accreditation Survey Visits.

In the three (3) days activity, the participants delve in the different trends, updates and directions on the Preliminary Survey Visit, Institutional Accreditation Survey levels 1-4, with interactive sessions and exercises to gain insights in identifying relevant materials and documents aligned to the Level 1-IV standard.



These trainings and workshop were supported by the university to continue the individual growth of the accreditors and ensure that they are well informed and updated to the new trends of accreditations. These training session can be very relevant and timely since the university will delve into different Accreditations this coming AY 2024-2025. This is done to ensure the students of the university that they are availing the quality of education as well as giving them an excellence service.











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#### **SERIES OF AACCUP INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION WORKSHOP**

#### FEBRUARY 13/15, 2024

A series of AACCUP Institutional Accreditation workshops was done for Vice Presidents, Directors, Campus Administrators, Deans, Faculty and Staff in preparation for the **>>>** University accreditation this year. Last February 13 and 15, 2024 librarians of the university library attended the first part of the workshop covering the Orientation and Preparation of documents.



#### **MARCH 1/24, 2024**

On March 01, 2024 a follow up meeting of the workshop was conducted to ensure the consistency of the bodies to the workshop likewise on March 24, 2024 personnel of the library attended for the follow-up workshop that focused on the final briefing, presentation and critiquing of documents to maintain the standard and quality of education in the institution.



#### **APRIL 15-17, 2024**

On April 15-17, 2024 actual AACCUP Institutional Accreditation workshop was performed by the participants including the librarians of the university. The Area that covered the workshop is from Area 1 up to Area IX that includes the Governance and Management, Teaching Learning and Evaluation, Faculty and Staff, Research, Extension, Consultancy and Linkage, furthermore, Support to Students, Library, Infrastructure and other learning resources as well as the Assurance culture.











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#### **CHED Conducts University Inspection: Programs Application for COPC**

The Commission on Higher Education (CHED) conducted an online inspection to Iloilo Science and Technology university (ISAT U) on June 3, 2024. This inspection is with regards to the university's application for COPC for its 12 programs namely BSECE, BSEE, BSCE, BSME, BSA, BIT ELX, BSBIO, BHS, BSCS, BSIS, MSCS and MaEd. This inspection included mo monitoring, review and evaluation of the program in different levels.

The library, as part of the academe plays a vital role in providing updated resources for the programs and giving quality service to its clientele especially for the new programs of the university. During the online inspection, Ms. Rovilyn D. somcio assured the body that ISAT U Library is equipped with the necessary documents for the accreditation and other program evaluations.


